Answers to Your Questions About Family Camp at Marannook

What is Family Camp? It's an opportunity to get away from your daily routine and spend time together in God's beautiful outdoors. Families will learn more about worshiping God together. After each meal, there will be an exciting Bible time with singing, skits, and plenty of fun!

Where will we stay? In your own bunkroom with private bath, climate control, and porch. Meals will be served in Manna Hall, our unique open-air dining hall.

Should we leave young children at home? No, you are welcome to bring babies; families have done it before with no problems. We'll provide high chairs at meals and child care whenever you need it. Your children will be involved in camp activities with the counselors.

Will we have quality time together as a family? Yes, parents and children will be together except on Saturday morning, when parents will meet for Biblical teaching and discussion on family worship. On Saturday night, the children will enjoy a bonfire with singing, sharing, and s'mores with the counselors, while the parents enjoy a special candlelight dinner.

Will our children spend much time with the counselors? During all meals and activities, our staff will be present to serve your family.

What are some Family Camp activities? You will canoe, shoot archery, ride the cable car, negotiate the Great Maze, tackle the Channel Challenge and weather permitting go swimming at the pool.
